The attainment of our pupils at the end of key stage two remains significantly above the national average and progress in maths and reading has improved however progress in writing is not as good as we would like.

Overall Progress

- 2.56 in Reading. This is 2.03 points more than the average for Outstanding schools and is 2.53 higher than the national average.
- -0.50 in Writing. This is 0.64 less than the average for Outstanding schools and is 0.53 points lower than the national average
- 0.69 in Maths. This is 0.34 more than the average for Outstanding schools and is 0.66 points higher than the national average

Areas of Strength

- Pupils achieving higher standard: Reading 60% (NA 28%) 3yr trend +36%
- Pupils achieving expected standard: Reading, Writing & Maths 84% (NA 64%) 3yr trend +13%

- Pupils achieving higher standard: EGPS 52% (NA 34%) 3yr trend +33%
- Pupils achieving expected standard: Reading 91% (NA78%) 3yr trend +9%.
- Pupils achieving expected standard: EGPS 94% (NA78%) 3yr trend +9%

Achieving Expected Standard

- 84% of pupils achieved the expected standard in **Reading, Writing and Maths**. This is 20% higher than the national average and 16% higher than the Outstanding schools average
- 92% of pupils achieved the expected standard in **Reading**. This is 17% higher than the national reading average and 16% higher than the Outstanding schools average.
- 87% of pupils are working at the expected standard in **Writing**. This is 9% higher than the national writing average and 10% higher than the Outstanding schools average.
- 90% of pupils achieved the expected standard in **Maths**. This is 15% higher than the national average and 15% higher than the Outstanding schools average.
- 94% of pupils achieved the expected standard in **EGPS**. This is 16% higher than the national average and 17% higher than the Outstanding schools average.

Achieving Higher Standard

19% of pupils achieved the higher standard in Reading, Writing and Maths. This is 6% more than Outstanding schools average and 10% more than the national average. Overall the percentage achieving the higher standards in Reading, Writing and Maths has increased by 13% per year since 2016, while the national rate of change has increased by 5% per year since 2016.

- 60% of pupils achieved a high scaled score in **Reading**. This is 27% higher than the Outstanding schools average and 32% higher than the national average.
- 29% of pupils were working at greater depth within the expected standard in **Writing**. This is 5% higher than the Outstanding schools average and 9% higher than the national average.
- 34% of pupils achieved the higher standard in **Maths**. This is 6% higher than the Outstanding schools average and 10% higher than the national average
- 52% of pupils achieved the higher standard in **EGPS**. This is 13% higher than the Outstanding schools average and 17% higher than the national average.
