Challenge: If 20% of the population live in China, what is the population of that country?

Discuss



Should we be worried about the effects of global warming to the planet? Is it something we can ignore? Is it something for future generations to worry about more than us? Is it important for us to do something now to prevent catastrophe in the future?

Fact: Global warming is the increase in the average world temperature, caused by certain gases in the Earth's atmosphere that act like glass in a greenhouse. This is also known as climate change.

Create a poster to warn of the dangers of global warming and how we can prevent something like this happening to the planet.

Planet Answers

How many people are there over 15 on the planet?	How many days does it take to get to the moon?
7 600 000 000 - 1 900 000 000 = 5 700 000 000 people are over 15 years old.	To find 20%, divide by 5: 7 600 000 000 ÷ 5 = 1 520 000 000 people live in China
