Notes:

1. After a successful start to the 2019-20 year with the Fireworks, Christmas activities and Quiz night, the impact of Covid-19 lockdown meant that there was minimal income for the remainder of the spring and summer terms. This was hugely disappointing for all but we were able to use the funds raised to that point to add some fun to the summer for those who could continue in school and fund the refurbishment of the Year 6 classrooms and Library which completes the 3-year project. We also supported the school with tissues and planners as usual.
2. Fireworks 2019 was a great success and raised £5,210 in profit. This year we invested in an iZettle device to enable us to take card payments both in advance at pop-up stalls and on the evening at the gate, this meant there was significantly less cash to handle. The event attracted 1600 attendees, 100 more than 2018, with around the same proportion purchasing their tickets upfront. The Kit Shop sold 80% of the presales tickets and we are hugely grateful to have their continued support. The Glo Toys stall made less profit this year due to sourcing more expensive, durable, stock to reduce the environmental impact of disposable items. We had additional security costs due to disruption in previous years however we also increased fees from external vendors. Unfortunately, there will not be a Fireworks event in 2020 due to Covid-19 which is a huge loss to our fundraising.
3. At Christmas, the children thoroughly enjoyed the disco which was very well attended and raised £265. We also raised £257 through Cauliflower cards and a whopping £1,000 from the Christmas raffle and refreshments at the Christmas Concerts.
4. In February we held a Quiz Night which raised £587 and was a great night. It was great to see tables of parents, teachers and friends of the school coming together.
5. The Rag Bag Scheme raised only £135 this year as it was not accessible during lockdown. Second hand uniform sales this year raised £100.
6. We received almost £450 in other donations this year. £120 was donated in Matchgiving and £205 was donated from Waitrose. We also registered the Friends with smile.amazon and easyfundraising which both make donations while you shop online. These schemes raised £123 and give us a great opportunity to raise funds while we are limited in the events we can hold.

The Friends of Oakfield School raised £7,303 in the 2019/20 school year and donated £7,967 to the school. Funds to date now total £ 7,193.
