






<p>English: Taught in own classes. Our genres for this term are: Dramatic conventions, Poetry and Persuasion. SPaG (Spelling/punctuation/ grammar) will be taught in an explicit lesson as well as included in writing sessions. Five Guided Reading whole class sessions per week. In addition to this, a daily whole class reading for enjoyment session and book study. Spelling lessons are taught weekly. Our 2nd half term topic will be The Earth, Sun and Moon. The Autumn Term focus will be on Place Value, 4 Operations and knowing and using number facts. Homework will be a mixture of calculation, problem solving, tables and arithmetic. Most tasks will be set online. Reminder: All children are subscribed to TTRockstars and Doodle Maths online, so please encourage them to use it! Passwords and Usernames have been distributed.</p>

<p>Homework: Children are expected to read 5 x per week for 25 mins. This should be recorded in their Homework Planner and signed weekly by a parent/adult. Homework for English, spellings and maths will be available on Google Classroom on Fridays to be handed in by the following Thursday. Each task should take no longer than 25-30 minutes; longer if a child is happy to continue. On occasion, Science, Topic or Art homework may be set as well as other tasks. We encourage parents to support their child with their learning as much as possible; Homework club takes place weekly for those pupils who do not have access to an electrical device which can connect to the internet.</p>		<p>Computing: E-safety (responsible usage) PowerPoint – using the hyperlink tool to create a quiz Excel – bar and line graphs</p>
