

<p><b>English:</b> Taught in own classes. Our genres for this term are: newspaper reports, narrative, instruction writing and poetry. <b>SPaG</b> (spelling/punctuation/ grammar) will be taught in explicit lessons as well as included in writing sessions. Five whole class reading sessions per week. In addition to this a daily whole class novel will be shared with the class. <b>Spelling</b> lessons are taught 3 times a week. <p><b>Homework:</b> Children are expected to read 5x per week for 30 mins. This should be recorded in their Homework Planner and signed weekly by a parent/adult. Homework for Maths and English is set on a Friday, to be completed by the following Friday. Spelling lists are set weekly and tested every Friday. Each task should take no longer than 30-35 minutes or longer if a child is happy to continue. On occasion, science, topic or art homework may be set or additional handwriting activities for those who need it. Homework club will take place weekly on a Wednesday during lunch for those pupils who do not have access to an electrical device which is connected to the internet on which to complete their homework.</p>		<p><b>Essentials/Daily Kit/Planner:</b>  Your child needs a pencil, rubber, sharpener, 30cm ruler, green pen, coloured pencils, whiteboard pen, glue stick and blue handwriting pen, kept in <b>one small pencil case</b>. Children are encouraged to wear watches. Only small plain stud earrings may be worn. Long hair is tied back with a <b>plain small band and correct socks should be worn</b>. No nail polish.
