- **Hands-on creative activities:** Using a variety of materials to design and make unique products.
- **Artistic techniques:** Developing skills in colour, texture, line, and 3D form using clay and recycled materials.

- **Help Us Survive!** – Creating 3D beaver habitats and river dams.
- **Rewilding Revolution** – Watercolor bamboo art and panda characters.
- **Change Makers** – Designing an environmental card game to take home
