

English: Genres for this term are: story, letter writing and non-fiction reports. SPAG (Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation) lessons are taught weekly as part of English lessons. Five Guided Reading whole class sessions per week. In addition to this, a daily whole class reading for enjoyment session and book study. Spelling lessons are taught weekly and words given to learn at home on a fortnightly basis. The year 3/4 statutory spelling list is available in pupils' planners. Homework: Children should read daily for 15 minutes, and this should be recorded in planners. Each week, they will be set: 1 maths & 1 English piece of homework. Each task should take 15 minutes or longer if a child is happy to continue. Spellings are set fortnightly. The school makes use of several online resources to support home learning. Homework is posted on Google classroom & written in planners. We encourage parents to support their child with their learning as much as possible. Homework Club - for those pupils who do not have access to a device which connects to the internet at home will take place weekly on a Tuesday during lunchtime. Any child who does not complete homework set will be asked to go to homework club to complete it.	Essentials/Daily Kit/Planner: Your child needs their planner in school every day, passwords for online platforms can be found at the back of these. Planners should be checked every day for messages and signed at the end of each week. Only small plain stud earrings may be worn. These MUST be removed on PE days (Tuesday and Wednesday). Long hair is tied back with a plain blue or black small band, and correct socks should be worn. No nail polish. School black shoes and not trainers to be worn. Uniform must be clearly named and worn correctly. Children are allowed a healthy snack for playtime and must bring a full water bottle each day. During the Autumn and Spring terms the children must have a coat in school each day. We supply the essential stationery required at school and in return ask parents to donate £15 per year through wisepay.
